<p>Read a book of your choice, and then draw a picture of your favourite part.</p> 	<p>Listen to a piece of music that is a favourite of someone in your family. Find out why they like it (and bring the information to school to share with the class).</p> 
<p>Find out about the jobs that people in your family are employed to do. What are the main duties and responsibilities of that job?</p> 	<p>Find out about a famous person from Sheffield and write a fact file about them</p> 
<p>In your home, measure and record the length of 15 different objects.</p> 	<p>Create a poster to help us learn our colours in French.</p>
