What will I be learning?

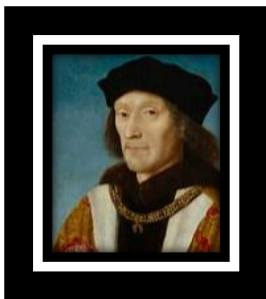
The Tudor period began in 1485 until 1603 and was a time when the Tudor family, represented by the red Tudor rose reigned over the British Empire. The most famous member of the Tudor family was King Henry VIII who is well known for having 6 different wives. During the Tudor period the Spanish Armada, a fleet of warships was sent to attack England and led by the fearless leader Sir Francis Drake. However his various attacks did not go to plan and were unsuccessful for many reasons including bad conditions and storms.
