

Distance learning tasks Year 1

1. **Learn spellings.** Use the Look, Say, Cover, Spell, Check sheet to practise and learn the common exception words for Year 1. Some of these we have learned in class already!
2. **Reading comprehensions.** Choose at least 3 of the reading comprehensions to complete. Read the information and then answer the questions below.
3. **Reading.** Choose a book that you are interested in reading. Aim to read aloud to someone else for 15 minutes every day to improve your fluency.
4. **Phonics.** Look at the real and alien words with your grown up. Use your phonics knowledge to sound out these words.
5. **Writing.** Write some facts about the Great Fire of London. You could include when the fire started and how many people died. Retell the story of the three little pigs.
6. **Maths.** Log on to TT Rock stars every day for at least 15 minutes to practise your times tables. Choose at least two units we have been focusing on this year and complete the tasks set within them.
7. **History.** Research the Great Fire of London and use this to help you write some facts about what happened. You could also refer to the Knowledge Organiser to learn some of the key people and vocabulary. In preparation for next half terms learning choose a famous King or Queen of England and write something you have found out about them.
8. **Science.** Using your knowledge from previous learning, can you sort the animals into the different animal groups. You could use <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PHYi4fqeEdw&t=303s> to help you. Use your knowledge of the different seasons to create a piece of artwork of what trees look like in the different seasons. There is also an activity where you can sort what clothes you would wear in each season.
9. **Geography.** Can you label the different counties within the UK. You could also find out the capital cities for each of the countries.
10. **RE.** Can you find out about Easter (Christianity) and Ramadan (Islam)? Who celebrates these festivals and why do we celebrate them? What might you do at these celebrations?
