

Distance learning tasks Year 2

1. **Learn spellings.** Use the Look, Say, Cover, Spell, Check sheet to practise and learn the common exception words for Year 2. Some of these we have learned in class already!
2. **Reading comprehensions.** Choose at least 3 of the reading comprehensions to complete. Read the information and then answer the questions below.
3. **Reading.** Choose a book that you are interested in reading. Aim to read aloud to someone else for 15 minutes every day to improve your fluency. See if you can find a poem to read and learn off by heart.
4. **Writing.** Read the attached story and re-write the story using some skills that are in the example eg expanded noun phrases (bright, glittery stars), conjunctions (and, because, when, but) and ambitious vocabulary (inspired, glide, intelligent, hoist). You can also try some of the other writing activities.
5. **Maths.** Log on to TT Rock stars every day for at least 15 minutes to practise your times tables.
6. **Maths.** Complete the attached maths activities. Make a note of anything you found tricky.
7. **History.** Research Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus to find new facts and compare the two explorers.
8. **Science** – use the Knowledge Organiser to learn key words linked to plants and their life cycle.
9. **RE.** These religious events all take place in March or April. Choose 2 of these events to research and find out about; Easter (Christianity), Pesach (Judaism), Holi (Hinduism) and Ramadan (Islam). Feel free to find out about an additional religious festival that hasn't been mentioned here.
