



# TEMPORARY AMENDMENT TO BEHAVIOUR POLICY

MAY 2020

## Behaviour

We understand that school will not feel like the place the children left behind in March. We also recognise that some children may feel anxious or unsettled by the changes we have had to implement. We hope to reassure you that we will support your child in whatever way we are safely able to do in order that they feel happy and secure whilst in our care. However, unfortunately there will have to be some changes to the way we implement our behaviour policy and it is crucial that your children are clear about what to expect.

Your children will be expected to:

- Remain in their designated 'bubble'. **This is non-negotiable**
- Listen carefully to and follow the instructions of the adults responsible for their 'bubble' at all times. This is not only for their own safety but that of the children and adults they are grouped with.
- Be courteous, polite and supportive of those within their bubble

Our Staff will:

- Have a designated member of staff responsible for each bubble
- Ensure the curriculum taught is engaging and exciting
- Provide reassurance and support throughout the day
- Give gentle reminders of behaviour expectations
- Ensure strict hygiene measures and safety routines are adhered to

**Should your child choose not to follow the instructions of staff and as a result put the health and safety of others in their 'bubble' at risk. The following will happen:**

- Your child will be brought the door of the classroom by the adult responsible for their bubble and either Mr Smith (Headteacher) or Mrs Bister (Deputy Headteacher) will meet them at the door and escort them to the office, **where they will be kept isolated from other children and staff.**
- Parents will then be contacted by school and you will then be asked to come and collect your child **immediately.**
- Your child will not be allowed to return to their 'bubble' until there are some reassurances and guarantees that this behaviour will not be repeated.

- Where these guarantees cannot be made, your child will be at risk of losing their place in school for the duration of the 'safety measures' being in place. Learning Packs or Digital Learning will be provided by school.

**Please note that support measures such as, 'time out' in other classes or with other members of staff is not permitted during this time.**

We hope you understand that these measures must be put in place in order to ensure the health and safety of all those in school. We encourage you to discuss these measures as appropriate with your children.
